SOS Rally

On Wed, Sept 17th --in lieu of our regular Youth Group - we will be taking part in a city-wide rally in preparation for **SOS (Serve Our Schools)**—see below for details) and SYATP (See You At The Pole). All the "Serve The City" youth groups will be gathering together this night to get excited about living a "Prayer, Care, Share" lifestyle in our schools this year. Students should meet at First Assembly from 7:00 – 8:45 PM. Bring \$5 for the SOS t-shirt and meet Terry, Diane and Amy in the lobby to find out where our group is sitting. The kickoff SOS/SYATP day is planned for the following Wednesday, Sept 24.

SOS Details: Here's the plan...

One Wednesday a month, starting on SYATP day--Sept 24--we will declare it to be "SOS Day," where students will be encouraged to do three things:

1. Wear the really cool SOS t-shirt to identify themselves in unity.
2. Focus on serving in the school that day either individually or in a cooperative way with the other SOS students: (car wash, food giveaway, cafeteria cleanup, appreciation events, spontaneous celebrations, etc.)
3. Invite onlookers to come visit their own youth group or ministry that night.

It's that simple! SOS is intended to be entirely student-led, with adults to help cast vision, encourage, and resource the students' efforts.

The success of any individual school's efforts will depend on the time, commitment, and passion invested by the Christian students there.

International Peacemaker, Rev. Enlin Li Guest Pastor at Hus on October 19th!

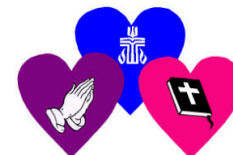
