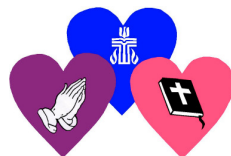

The Hus Racing League is held at Hus Presbyterian Church, 2808 Schaeffer DR. SW (3 blocks East of J St. SW on 29<sup>th</sup> Ave.), Cedar Rapids Iowa.

Registration begins at 9:30 AM and races start at 10 AM on the second Saturday of each month from February to November. First time racers will want to arrive early in order to choose a racing number, label their cars with that number and place their cars into the appropriate classes. This also gives racers a chance to chat with fellow racers and see what the competition will be like that month.

Based on the number of entries, we will typically race two classes and then break for a devotional and then for lunch. Lunch will be available or racers can go out. After lunch the remaining classes will race. HRL Bucks and points will be awarded for the top four finishers in each class. HRL Bucks are used to purchase prizes at the prize table. Points will accumulate throughout the racing season and at the end of the season the top four racers in each class will receive trophies and medals.

## Rules for the Racing Season

Races are scheduled to start at 10:00am on the second Saturday of the month from February to November.

Racers must be present during the entirety of the race classes they are entered in to be eligible for points awarded.

All classes have the same point scale for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place. A racer cannot place more than once per class. When we get down to 8 cars left in a class, if anyone has more than 1 car in it, they will race themselves until they are down to one car. This enables more racers to score points.

Cars entered in the wrong class cannot be re-entered in the right one. If you are unsure what class to enter a car into, ask a race official. Once a class has begun, registration ends for that class. Cars are announced for each race so racers will know when their car is racing. Make sure your cars are numbered and legible, if they are not they will be disqualified.

Points awarded are: 10 for 1<sup>st</sup> place, 6 for 2<sup>nd</sup> place, 3 for 3<sup>rd</sup> place, and 1 for 4<sup>th</sup> place

Registration is \$1 for 4 cars or \$5 for 24 (maximum). You may enter your cars in one or all of the classes you are eligible for. 75% of the registration goes towards the monthly prizes. The other 25% goes towards the year end trophies.

During the regular season, the champion of each class will retire until the season championship in November. In other words, if your car wins its class, you "garage it" until November, when it will race in the CAR OF THE YEAR Championship. This race will honor the fastest car entered in each class throughout the entire season. All current champions will then race in the final grand championship race, the Hus CUP CHAMPIONSHIP.

We will give thanks to God through a devotional time during the racing day. Participating in the devotional time is not required to race.

This is a Hus Church sponsored program. The HRL board will answer questions and resolve all disputes.

## Classes

**Kids Class:** Anyone 15 years old or younger can enter. These cars are strictly non-modified cars. All cars are eligible except the Fast Ferraris & Funny Cars, which race only in their own class.

**Rookie's Class:** This class is added for drivers who have never raced before this year. Any driver with previous experience prior to this year is NOT eligible in this class. Drivers also visiting the race "to see what this is about" would race in this class. Inexperienced drivers are NOT limited to this class, however. All cars are eligible except the Fast Ferraris & Funny Cars, which race in their own class. Anyone achieving 10 or more points in one racing season graduates from the Rookies Class being ineligible in the class for the rest of their racing career (Congratulations!).

**Late Model Class:** Anyone can enter in this class. These cars are strictly non-modified and have a casting date of 2005 or newer. Race officials prior to the races being run will check the casting dates. Funny Cars, the Fast Ferraris and pickups/trucks do not race in this class.

**Super Stock Class:** Anyone can enter in this class. These cars are strictly non-modified and have a casting date between 1978 and 2004. Anniversary cars and later makes of pre-1978 castings are eligible in this class. Race officials prior to races being run will check the casting dates. Funny Cars, the Fast Ferraris and pickups/trucks do not race in this class.



## Classes, cont.

**Trucks Class:** Anyone can enter this class. These trucks are strictly non-modified. These trucks can have any casting date. If any questions arise during pre-race setup as to whether it is eligible for the class, please see a race official. Included in this class are pickups, trucks, ambulances, and any customs produced by die-cast companies.

**Redlines Class:** Anyone can enter in this class. These cars are strictly non-modified and must have been manufactured in 1977 or before. Cars can be from any brand, i.e.: Hot Wheels, Matchbox, Johnny Lightning, etc. No anniversary cars or later makes of original castings are allowed in this class. This class is to honor the die-cast car heritage.

**Racing Car Class:** Anyone can enter in this class. These cars are strictly non-modified and are legitimate Cup Series cars. All cars with true NASCAR paint schemes and actual die-cast of racing cars i.e. pickups/trucks, four-doors, Chevy stockers, and t-bird stockers are eligible. Beginning in Aug 06, all racing cars are eligible in this class except the Funny Cars and the Fast Ferraris.

**Funny Cars / Fast Ferraris Class:** Anyone can enter in this class. The Funny Cars must have a flip-up body, be strictly non-modified and cannot be glued shut or the body fastened down in any way. We are also including in this class the three fastest models of Ferraris made (and proven). These models are the F-40, the 308 & the Testarossa. This is the only class that the Funny Cars and the three specified Ferraris can race in.
